Location:	K-State growth chamber, Manhattan, KS	
Planting Date:	01 April, 2009	
Infestation Dates:	08 April, 2009 (Approx. 12 female HF's / treatment) – 1 week after planting	
Rating Date:	30 April, 2009	
Experimental Design:	Completely Randomized. Each pot contained 4 replications and each replication consisted of 6 plants	
Evaluation:	Counted number of larvae and/or pupae (flaxseeds) on 4 plants/replication.
